A Profile of the College

Govt. Degree College, Arki came into being on 6th July, 1994. Since its inception, the college has risen from strength to strength and has progressively made its mark as one of the leading institution of higher learning in Himachal Pradesh. This co-educational institute provides an ideal ambience to the students for pursuit of learning and development of personality. The college is affiliated to the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla under sections 2(f) and 12 (B) of UGC act and has been accredited 'B' Grade by NAAC. Its reaccreditation process is in progress. The college offers different undergraduate programs in humanities, science (Medical and Non Medical) and commerce. We also have a course of Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) being run under self-financing scheme. All these courses confirm to the Choice Based Credit System of RUSA. The college has evolved as a fountain-head of learning providing quality education to students of the Arki region, which is primarily a rural area. It has adequate infrastructure in terms of classrooms, laboratories, library, computer lab with Wi-Fi connection and modern facilities and a playground, etc. It has separate Arts, Science and Administrative Blocks. Recently, smart classrooms have been introduced and Wi-Fi has been provided on the Campus.

The motto of our College is "Vidyayaa amritam ashnute," which means "We attain Immortality through Knowledge". Our vision is to build a holistic and vibrant learning environment founded on value based academic principles to inculcate mental and spiritual strength in order to develop the character of the students. Different activities in the college such as sports, cultural, NSS, rovers and rangers are instrumental in channelizing the strength of the students. Over the years the college has acquired an excellent reputation by exhibiting outstanding performance in academics, sports and co-curricular activities.

RUSA Grant

The RUSA Advisory Committee of the college has done a commendable job under the supervision of its convener **Dr. Daleep Sharma**. The College received grant of `2 crore from the central/state funding under RUSA in the year 2015. The grant of `1.5 crore was utilized between the years 2015-17, according to the prescribed norms and standards. The grant of `50 lakh which the College has received this year is also being spent for the up-lift-ment of the institutional development. The IQAC cell had certain plans mentioned in the self-reviewed progress report of 2017-18 to NAAC, which are accomplished this year with the scrupulous intendance of Dr. Daleep Sharma, the co-ordinator of RUSA.

IQAC

The IQAC is a part of the institution's system and works towards realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. Under the coordinator-ship of **Dr. Ramesh Sharma** the IQAC Cell has developed a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of this institution. The IQAC Cell has submitted its four previous year's annual self-reviewed progress report to NAAC. The IQAC cell shoulders the responsibility of generating and promoting awareness in the institution and for this it has taken feedback from the alumni, parents and students.

The IQAC conducted an inter-College declamation contest on the National Democratic setup as an awareness programme of The Election Commission of India, in collaboration with the electoral club of College and the Sub-division election office Arki.

- ✓ The IT lab was renovated with new flooring, the furniture was repaired and acoustics aluminum partition was done in the lab.
- ✓ Podium and digital teaching system has also been installed in the newly constructed multipurpose hall.
- ✓ The library has also been renovated with 32 steel chairs, 8 library tables and 1 magazine display board.
- ✓ New furniture has been purchased for the newly constructed Seminar room, multipurpose computer lab, and the conference room.
- ✓ Girl's Common room has been refurnished with the dressing table and 8 chrome plated benches.
- ✓ 2 chrome plated benched are also installed in the waiting room to facilitate the visitors.
- ✓ The Chemistry lab has been renovated with steel stands and cup-boards.
